



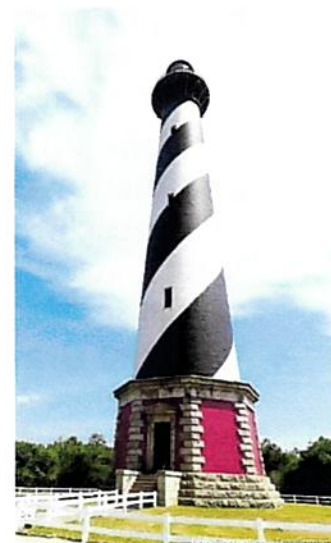

- ✿ **Tour Whalehead in Historic Corolla ~** Wander through this northern Outer Banks icon. Learn about its history while viewing original Tiffany glass sconces, corduroy walls, Otis elevator, and other ornate details.
- ✿ **Dolphin Cruise ~** Enjoy breathtaking views while cruising through the Roanoke Sound and learn about the Atlantic bottlenose Dolphins. While the boat is moving, dolphins will be playing in their natural habitat alongside the vessel. There is also other wildlife such as pelicans, ospreys and other birds that congregate in the Sounds.







✿ **Climb Aboard the Elizabeth II – A Recreated 16<sup>th</sup> Century Ship** ~ Experience 16th-century shipboard life in motion. A 69-foot sailing vessel, the Elizabeth II is modeled after one of the seven English merchant ships that sailed to the New World in 1585.

✿ **Visit Roanoke Island Festival Park** ~ Step back in time at Roanoke Island Festival Park, where history comes to life! Since the first English attempt at colonization in 1587, Roanoke Island has played a crucial role in shaping North Carolina and America's story.

✿ **Explore the Elizabethan Gardens** ~ The gardens commemorate the lost colonists of Roanoke and provide a glimpse into the Elizabethan era. Stroll through a diverse collection of flowering plants, trees, shrubs, and more that offer a colorful display throughout the year.

✿ **Visit the Wright Brothers National Memorial and Visitor Center** ~ Wind, sand, and a dream of flight brought Wilbur and Orville Wright to Kitty Hawk, North Carolina where they achieved the first successful airplane flights in 1903.

✿ **Visit the Graveyard of the Atlantic Museum** ~ This museum displays artifacts and presents a variety of exhibits and interprets the rich maritime culture that includes war, piracy, ghost ships, and more.
