



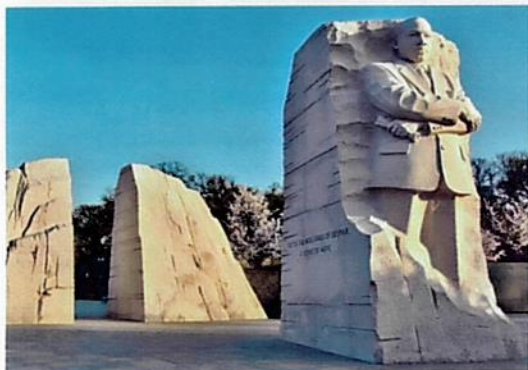

- ∞ **Explore the National Museum of African American History & Culture –** *Opened in 2016, this is the only national museum devoted exclusively to the documentation of African American life, art, history, and culture. The building's patterned bronze facade references the history of African American craftsmanship, and a series of openings throughout the exhibition spaces frame views of the Washington Monument and the White House.*



- ∞ **Guided African American History Tour of Washington DC -** *Discover many of Washington DC's most significant African-American historical and cultural landmarks. You'll see sights such as the Mary Bethune House, The Whitehall Hotel, and much more.*
- ∞ **Visit the Martin Luther King Memorial -** *Located in downtown Washington, DC, the memorial honors Martin Luther King, Jr.'s legacy and the struggle*

for freedom, equality, and justice. A prominent leader in the modern civil rights movement, Dr. King was a tireless advocate for racial equality, the working class, and the oppressed around the world.

- ☞ **Guided Riding Tour of Washington DC** - To include such sights (as time permits): *The Supreme Court, Capitol Building, Georgetown, National Archives, Smithsonian Institution, Washington's Monuments, the Lincoln, Vietnam and Korean Veterans Memorials, also FDR, Jefferson Memorials, the Pentagon Memorial, and World War II Veterans Memorial.*
- ☞ **Tour the Frederick Douglass National Historic Site** – *Escaping slavery, Frederick Douglass became a leading voice in the abolitionist movement. For his entire life, he fought for equality and justice for all people. explore Cedar Hill, the estate Fredrick Douglass lived at from 1877 to his death in 1895.*

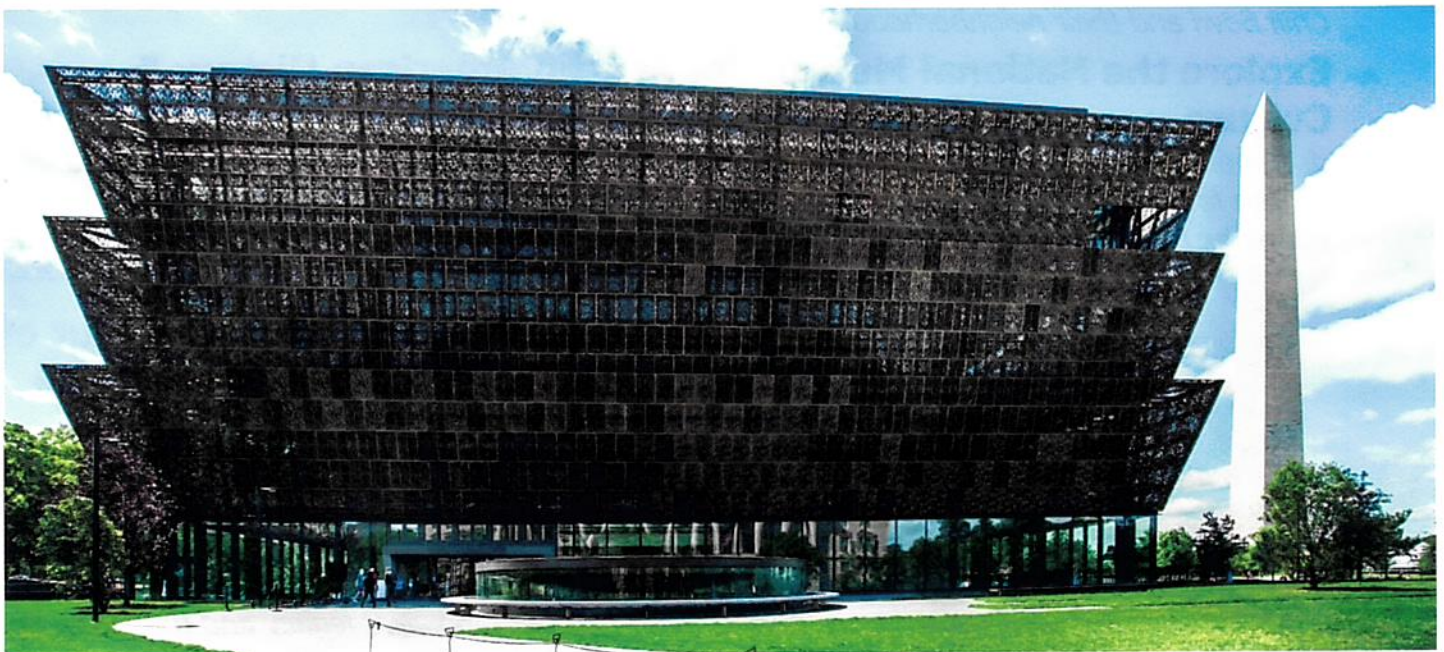
